**Preparatory activities:** The activities involved 12 participants, including 2 participants from Finland, 1 participant from Italy, 1 participant from Germany, 1 participant from Sweden, 1 participant from Lithuania, 1 participant from Estonia, 1 participant from Spain, 1 participant from Denmark, 1 participant from Austria, 1 participant from Greece and 1 participant from Slovenia.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Milan, Italy, from 21/07/2021 to 25/07/2021

**Short description:** The aim of this activity was that the representatives of the partners to get know each other, discussed the objectives of the project and each event, and prepare the following four events.

**Events:**

4 events have been carried out within this project:

**Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 36 citizens, including 2 participants from Finland, 8 participants from Italy, 1 participant from Germany, 1 participant from Sweden, 1 participant from Malta, 5 participants from Lithuania, 1 participant from Estonia, 2 participants from Spain, 3 participants from Denmark, 1 participant from Austria, 5 participants from Greece, 5 participants from Slovenia and 1 participant from Ireland.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Copenhagen, Denmark from 09/08/2021 to 12/08/2021.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to learn lessons from the recent history (mainly last 75 years) and use these to contribute to inclusive and peaceful societies. We made a video of what we learned.

**Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved 26 citizens, including 2 participants from Finland, 3 participants from Italy, 1 participant from Germany, 1 participant from Romania, 1 participant from Sweden, 4 participants from Lithuania, 2 participants from Estonia, 2 participants from Spain, 5 participants from Denmark, 2 participants from Austria, 1 participant from Greece, 1 participant from Slovenia and 1 participant from Ireland.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Tallinn, Estonia, from 01/09/2021 to 04/09/2021.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to dig into what polarisation in society is, and practice a method of mediating between people of different view. Based on what we learned we made a podcast series and we also shared the description of the mediating method.

**Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 25 citizens, including 5 participants from Finland, 1 participant from Italy, 2 participants from Germany, 1 participant from Romania, 3 participants from Sweden, 4 participants from Malta, 2 participants from Estonia, 2 participants from Spain, 2 participants from Denmark, 2 participants from Austria, 2 participants from Greece.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Cluj-Napoca, Romania from 25/05/2022 to 29/05/2022.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to make use of what was learned during the last two activities, and based on this learning, the participants brainstormed actions for inclusion and peaceful societies. These ideas were further developed at next activity.

**Event 4**

**Participation:** The event involved 28 citizens, including 6 participants from Finland, 1 participant from Italy, 2 participants from Germany, 1 participant from Romania, 4 participants from Sweden, 1 participant from Malta, 3 participants from Lithuania, 1 participant from Estonia, 1 participant from Spain, 1 participant from Denmark, 1 participant from Austria, 2 participants from Greece, 3 participants from Slovenia and 1 participant from Ireland.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Vilnius, Lithuania from 15/06/2022 to 19/06/2022.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to develop the action plans for inclusion and peace further, so they are ready to be carried out by the event participants. We also made presentations in video format to share the project descriptions for others to use.
