



Nordic Youth Organisation (NordYouth)

INVITATION TO GENERAL ASSEMBLY 2022

NordYouth's members are hereby invited to the General Assembly on 2nd of April 2022. The General Assembly will take place 13-17:30 WET and it is possible to participate in Torshavn, Faroe Islands or online. Additionally, a workshop about NordYouth is arranged at 10:00 locally in Torshavn. External organisations with an interest in NordYouth's activities are also welcome to be represented at the General Assembly and the Anniversary.

Key points of the agenda:

- Annual report 2022, updates about the 2022 activities, activity plan 2023
- Final accounts 2021 and Budget 2023
- Membership issues
- Election of 4 Board Members (not Chairperson) and depute members. The election is for 2 years.
- Election of Auditor and Internal Auditor. The election is made for 1 year.

Voting rights and participation format: Organisations with full membership in NordYouth are entitled to two (2) votes at the General Assembly, and should be used by two separate persons. Participation and voting can be done physically or online. Hopefully as many as possible can participate physically.

Material: According to the statutes, members should send material they wish to process at the General Assembly to the secretariat at least 6 weeks in advance to the General Assembly, which means no later than the 19th of February. Nominations of Board Member candidates can preferably be sent by this deadline, but it is possible to nominate candidates until the General Assembly. Most proposals and announcements can be sent freely formulated to the NordYouth secretariat at the address info@nordung.org, but for nomination of Board Member candidates, please use the form found here <https://www.nordung.org/medlemskap> under "Material for Members. NordYouth's secretariat will share the meeting material no later than a month before the meeting.

Financial rules and practical arrangements regarding travel, meals and accommodation:

- NordYouth pays travel reimbursement for meeting participants from Greenland to maximum 850€ per General Assembly. The actual payment cannot exceed the actual travel costs, and it can be paid for one participant or distributed over several.
- Participants from all other countries and self-governing areas receive no travel reimbursement.
- NordYouth provides the meeting participants lunch and coffee/tea during the General Assembly.
- Meeting participants or their organisations pay for the other meals and for accommodation.
- These rules also apply to board members who attend the General Assembly.
- We will shortly inform about address for the meeting, suggestions for accommodation and information about where we can commonly have dinner on the 1st and 2nd of April.

Language: The meeting language(s) is/are chosen so that the content can be understood by all participants, which in practice means the meeting will be held in Scandinavian and/or English.

Workshop: The workshop held prior to the General Assembly gives insight in NordYouth's recent development and upcoming plans, as well as possibility to give response and suggestions. Same material will also be shared digitally together with the meeting material, so response and suggestions can be given by email to the secretariat.
